DUAL ENROLLMENT VS. AP (ADVANCED PLACEMENT)

AP

- Allows students to take college level courses and exams to earn college credit or placement while still in high school.
- NO GUARANTEE upon completion of course; must pass the AP exam with a 3 or higher score.
- Taught by teachers trained by college board.
- Courses are taught at the high school and online thru Virtual Virginia.
- Open to any student.
- Cost approximately \$100 per exam.

DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Allows students to simultaneously earn high school and college credit by completing courses at the high school.
- Guaranteed college credit upon successful completion of the course.
- Taught by college instructors and/or high school teachers who serve as adjunct faculty.
- Courses are taught at the high school, at a Laurel Ridge Campus, or online thru Laurel Ridge C.C.
- Must have high school approval and meet the admission and prerequisite requirements.
- Students receive a discounted tuition rate of up to 75% off the regular Laurel Ridge tuition.

WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN CLASSES DUAL ENROLLED AT SHERANDO AND AT LAUREL RIDGE COMMUNITY COLLEGE

- All classes taken at Sherando follow Frederick County Public School Policy for attendance and grading.

Students taking classes at Laurel Ridge Community College follow certain college and Federal guidelines such as:

- ATTENDANCE: College classes have attendance policies that are stated in the course syllabus. College instructors also set their own attendance and grading policy.
- FERPA: (FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHT AND PRIVACY ACT) All college personnel are prohibited from discussing a student's work, progress or grades with anyone other than the student.
- GRADES: Grades are non-negotiable. What you earn is what you are given. Professor rarely, if ever, provide extra credit. Most professors find it insulting if you ask them.
- STUDY TIME: Students should allow themselves 2 hours of outside study time for each hour of in-class instruction to complete assignments, assigned readings, and projects.
- NO EXCUSES: Students are obligated to follow the assignment calendar for each course taken. College professors do not accept excuses for late work or for activities that go on outside of the classroom such as PROM, BEACH WEEK, HOMECOMING, or COMPUTER ISSUES.

IS DUAL ENROLLMENT A GOOD FIT?

Students who succeed in dual enrollment are
.....PROACTIVE!!!!!!!

- Highly motivated and hardworking
- Not prone to procrastination
- Determined to graduate with college credits
- Ready to deal with controversial issues and subject matter in a mature way
- Comfortable asking instructors questions
- And most importantly...they are willing to get help when they are struggling.

- Research the colleges and universities you are thinking about applying to and find out how dual enrollment may impact the following:
 - How will your credits transfer? Will the credits apply to your program of study? Visit www.transfervirginia.org to see how your credits may transfer.
 - Will it impact your admission process? Some colleges and universities may require you to apply for admission as a transfer student instead of a 1st year freshman.
 - How will your financial aid be impacted?
- Do you have enough time to allow yourself to study properly and be successful?

Grade is based on the semester grade and you are only getting credit in 1 college class per semester. For example ENG 111 is a Fall Semester credit for AP English 11; ENG 112 is the Spring semester credit.

Grade is based on end of the year grade and you are only getting credit in 1 college class.

WHAT IS THE COST?

Sherando students pay approximately 25% of the tuition price that Laurel Ridge students pay.

ENROLLMENT PROCESS

STEP #1 -- Applying to Laurel Ridge

- All first time dual enrollment students must apply to Laurel Ridge Community College. Previous dual enrollment students do not need to reapply.
- To begin go to www.laurelridge.edu/apply
- Login to the application using the “Sign in with Google” and use the students Sherando email and password or choose “Create an Account” and complete the login requirements. If choosing the “Create an Account” option; it is only good for 30 days.
- Step by step instructions are available with the Dual Enrollment Handouts given to students.
- Be sure to write down or better yet, take a picture of the EMPLID #, username and password for the MyLaurelRidge Account.
- Do not print out and sign the application. Neither the college nor Sherando require a copy of the application.

DUAL ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Step #2 -- Admission and Prerequisite Requirements

- Instead of placement testing we are using Dual Enrollment Admission and Placement Measures. The measures are based on CUMULATIVE HIGH SCHOOL GPA and the level of Math that has been completed.
 - Example 1 -- A student taking AP English 11 must have a GPA of 3.0
 - Example 2 -- A student taking Metal Fabrication must have a GPA of 2.0
 - Example 3 -- A student taking AP Statistics would need a 3.0 GPA and a grade of “B” or higher in Algebra 1 and 2, or submit an SAT Score of 530, or higher or ACT 22.
- GPAs do not get rounded up. A 2.99 gpa is what it is. This is strictly enforced by the college.
- Individual course requirements are available with the student handouts

DUAL ENROLLMENT PROCESS

Step #3 -- Enrollment Forms

COMPLETE THE HIGH SCHOOL DUAL ENROLLMENT REGISTRATION FORM

- Purple form is for the fall semester and full year courses
- Yellow form is for the spring semester courses and will be given out to students shortly after we return from winter break
- Make sure you check the right class and teacher
- Forms must be signed by the STUDENT and PARENT
- Mr. Bucher will take care of getting the Principal signature once all the required paperwork and payment is received. Please do not go to Mr. Nelson to get a signature; he will not do it.
- Complete the forms in BLACK or BLUE ink. Pencil will not be accepted.

HOW TO PAY FOR TUITION

- Calculate the number of credits/units that are being taken on the purple form
- Take the total number of credits/units and match it to the tuition chart that is provided in the student handout. The student will pay the Sherando Tuition Price in the right-hand column.
 - For example: student taking 12 total credits will pay \$514.80 for the semester
- Payment may be made using MySchoolBucks. Please be sure to select SHS DUAL ENROLLMENT as the category and enter the tuition amount. There is a default number in the total box; please be sure you put your total cost in that and print out your receipt. A receipt is required to be turned in with the registration form.
- You may also pay with check made payable to **SHERANDO HIGH SCHOOL**.
- Cash is also accepted but must be for the exact amount; we do not have change.
- Tuition must be paid in full for the semester.
- Graduated payments may be allowed for families in need. Email or call Mr. Bucher in the school counseling office to discuss options.

PAPERWORK SUBMISSION

Beginning on Monday, August 22; students may begin turning in the following:

- Purple Registration Form with both student and parent signatures
- Tuition payment made by cash or check made payable to Sherando High School or a copy of your MySchoolBucks receipt.
- Students using SAT, ACT or AP scores to meet prerequisite requirements must attach a copy of those scores. We will only accept documents that have the students full name and address on it. Be sure you download the scores and print them out. Do not print them using the print screen feature.
- You may give everything to Mr. Bucher before school starts and after school until 3:00 each day. You may also turn them in during the 5 and 6 period study halls as well. Mr. Bucher will be located outside the School Counseling Office.
