The School Board reserves the right to change the calendar in relation to holiday observance and make-up days (see school board policy). The 2021-22 school calendar has 185 student days; a fixed last day of school; and 5 built-in inclement weather days.

***Calendar subject to adjustment based on need to remain in compliance with VA Code: § 22.1-98. Reduction of state aid when length of school term below 180 days or 990 hours. (See below)

1. The length of every school's term in every school division shall be at least 180 teaching days or 990 teaching hours in any school year; and

2. If the length of the term of any school or the schools in a school division shall be less than 180 teaching days or 990 teaching hours in any school year, the amount paid by the Commonwealth from the Basic School Aid Fund shall, except as otherwise hereinafter provided or as otherwise provided by law, be reduced in the same proportion as the length of the school term has been reduced in any school or the schools in the school division from 180 teaching days or 990 teaching hours.

The calendar has 185 student days, including five built-in inclement weather days. Based on the number of inclement weather days, student instructional days will not exceed 180 days. Some days may be adjusted in this calendar at the conclusion of potential weather at the discretion of the Superintendent. If less than five student days are missed due to inclement weather, the calendar will be adjusted to provide students with additional days off in April or May. If more than five student days are missed due to inclement weather, the number of instructional hours will be calculated to be certain the minimum requirement of 990 instructional hours is met. The last day of school is June 10, 2022, and will not change regardless of how many student days are missed due to inclement weather. In addition, graduation dates will not change. Commencement exercises will be held on the specified dates, either indoors or outdoors, depending on the weather.
