Student Fee Waiver or Reduction

As stated in Policy 729P, Operations and Finance- School Fees, Charges and Collections, the Superintendent or his/her designee may reduce or waive fees and charges for economically disadvantaged students and students whose families are undergoing economic hardships and cannot pay. Those families include, but are not limited to, those receiving unemployment benefits or public assistance including Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), Supplemental Security Income (SSI) or Medicaid; foster families caring for children in foster care; and families that are homeless. All requests for student fee waivers and reductions are to be submitted directly to the student's principal using the [Student Fee Waiver or Reduction Form](#).
